Compass is a nationally recognized and registered organization in South Africa. Our team has researched the culture of charity on a global scale and the pressure of the socio-economic climate that has placed the lower levels of society outside of our socio-economic structure. Over the past 13 years COMPASS has been caring for abused and abandoned babies, children and mothers.



Home Is Where The Heart Is

We shelter and provide a dignified home environment, where people from disadvantaged backgrounds are given a second chance in life. We provide humanitarian assistance to the ones in our care by offering, nutritional meals three times a day, medical assistance (when needed) and education.



Education/Training

We run a care center with qualified caregivers and pre-school teachers. We also welcome people from the community, especially single moms and dads, domestic workers and unemployed parents who cannot afford to feed and educate their children, a free of charge entry with three nutritious meals a day. The children undergo a program of school readiness by our trained staff. Our objective is to educate our children at their level, empowering mothers through workshops and training with the opportunity to learn and earn an income.



Social Development

Our objective is to provide the best possible place of safety for abandoned, abused or disadvantaged woman and children, rehabilitating them into society. All programs are supervised by our very own senior social worker.



Our Care Centers:

The care centers provide a sense of security and a warm homely environment is created.



The Vegetable Garden:

The residences in the care centers plant and grow their own vegetables. They also eat and enjoy reaping the rewards from the vegetables.
